Asa Rivenburg

Asa Rivenburg, 58, died Monday in Little Falls hospital, in which he had been a patient since last Saturday. Mr. Rivenburg had been in ill health for about two years.

He was born on August 14, 1888 in St. Johnsville, and for some time had resided on route 5, in the Town of St. Johnsville, about two miles east of the village. He was a son of Mrs. Louise Wells Rivenburg and the late John Rivenburg.

Deceased was a carpenter by trade. He had spent his entire life in this section, and had a host of friends, who will mourn his passing.
