Benjamin Harrison Robb, from a serious illness of typhoid fever, entered into rest Sunday morning, June 30, shortly after 6 o'clock. During his one week of confinement he was troubled with heart weakness, and on the seventh day the heart failed utterly. Ben died at the home of his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Robb, of Clarendon, where he was born December 10, 1888. He was a young man of 18 years. He was earnest, kind hearted, with a smile and good word for every one, always thoughtful for his own family and his many true friends. His funeral was held from the house of his parents in Clarendon, Tuesday, Rev. F. [Frank] J. Angel [Universalist] officiating. Interment in the West Hillside cemetery. He leaves to mourn his loss, besides his parents, two sisters, Mrs. Carrie Seiger of Kendall, and Mrs. Laura Maxon of Clarendon, and two brothers, William Robb of Rochester, and Franklin C. Robb of Clarendon.
