MALVINA O. ROBB

Native of Webster Dies at Home of Sister There

Webster, April 17—Malvina O. Robb died at the home of her sister, Miss Mary E. Andrews, on Main street, this village, Saturday noon at 12 o'clock. She was born in the town of Penfield, now Webster, September 9, 1823, and was the daughter of the late Zenas and Sophronia Andrews. About sixty years ago she married Joseph E. Robb, who died in 1876, since which time she had made her home with her sister, in this village. She was for many years a member of the Universalist Church of this place, and was always zealous to its interests, seldom being absent from its services. She leaves one sister, Mary E. Andrews, of Webster; and one brother, Willis Andrews, of Egypt, N.Y.

The funeral will be held Monday in the Universalist Church, Rev. C. A. Simmons officiating.
