Horace B. Roberts

Horace Burton Roberts died at his home at Index, Tuesday. Mr. Roberts had been in poor health for the past sixteen months, but death came very suddenly. The funeral was held Thursday at 3 p.m. from his late home, the Rev. C. [Charles] Kramer of the Universalist church of Cooperstown officiating. Interment at Fly Creek cemetery.

Horace Burton Roberts was born June 15, 1876, at Oaksdale, a son of Horace Roberts and Louise Ellsworth. He was married, February 8, 1899 to Alice E. Matthews of Flycreek. He had been employed for the past nine years by the International Milk Products Company at Cooperstown. He is survived by his wife, four sons, Cassius, Ralph, Roy and Burton; and two daughters, Hilda and Charlotte, all residing at home, the oldest child being fourteen years of age. His father, Horace Roberts of Oaksville, and one sister, Mrs. A. H. Cross of Gouverneur, also survive.
