

[Robertson, Schuyler]

Schuyler, son of Robert [and Isabel Mills] Robertson, born May 15, 1808, died April 20, 1898. He was one of the early farmers of the town of Carroll, Chautauqua county, New York, where he settled in 1835. He was a farmer and also engaged in lumbering. He was a Universalist in religious faith, and in politics first an old-line Whig, later a Republican. He married, July 19, 1835, Polly Foster Clark, born March 19, 1812, died January 2, 1871. Children: 1. Lucius Mortimer [born in Jamestown, New York, April 2, 1836, died in Brooklyn, New York, November 9, 1901, buried in Maple Grove cemetery at Frewsburg; married, November 7, 1861, Elizabeth Ann, daughter of John T. and Lydia (Stevens) Myers. They were the parents of 13 children.] 2. Mary A., born January 24, 1843, died August 17, 1903. She married C.G. Mitchell of Utica, New York; no [children]. 3. Clark, born May 8, 1849.
