DAVID C. ROBINSON OF RICHFIELD SPRINGS
WAS TOWN ASSESSOR

Richfield Springs, July 15.—David C. Robinson, a prominent resident of this village, died at his home about 9 o'clock yesterday morning. Mr. Robinson is believed to have become despondent and while his wife was attending a funeral took his own life.

Mr. Robinson was a son of the late Charles and Elizabeth Mann Robinson. He was born at the Robinson homestead in the town of Richfield, December (5?), 1847. He married Elizabeth Shaul in 1874, and moved with her to Richfield Springs in 1891. He was an ardent Republican in politics and was town assessor at the time of his death, having served in that capacity for many years. He was a member of the Universalist Church and of the Deowongo Club. Mr. Robinson was an honest, upright citizen and his passing will be greatly mourned. Besides his wife he is survived by one son, Macy Robinson of Utica, and two sisters, Mrs. Charles Bullion of Richfield Springs and Mrs. Matilda Firman of Monticello.

The funeral will be held Wednesday, Rev. F. [Frank] O. Hokerk of Herkimer officiating.
