Lena C. Robinson was born in the town of Gainesville, Wyoming County, New York, on the 31st day of October 1884, and died in Colorado Springs, Colorado, January 23, 1909. Her funeral was held at her home on Monday afternoon, January 24th. Rev. Bernard C. Ruggles of the First Universalist Church of Colorado Springs officiated. Mrs. Price sang two beautiful solos.

A loving daughter, sister and friend has gone but will never be forgotten. Of a kind and gentle disposition she had endeared herself to a large circle of friends. When she left Delevan for her new home in the West it was in the hope of regaining her health, which had been failing for some time, but as the months went by she realized the wish was not to be granted. She made many friends in her new home and when death came they covered her casket with flowers, just as her eastern friends would have done could they have had the privilege.

Lena was graduated from the Delevan High School in 1901 and from the Teachers Training Class in January 1903. Her record as a student and as a teacher is the very best. If all who remember her with kindness, love and respect could speak to her; parents and sister in their far-away home, there would be the sound of many voices.

She had been a member of the Universalist Church for many years, and, while life was very sweet, she died loving Him who called her from earth.
