MRS. L. D. ROSE

Mrs. Aremitta Rose, an aged and respected resident of the town of Adams, died Sunday, March 12, aged 81 years. Mrs. Rose was the youngest daughter of Isaac Churchill of Watertown. For many years she has been a devoted member of the Universalist church.

In 1845 she was married to Lyman D. Rose of the town of Henderson. In 1859 her husband died, leaving her with four children. About this time invalidism began slowly to creep upon her and she was obliged to give up her busy, energetic life, little by little, until, for the last two years, she has been confined to her bed. She is survived by two sons, Silas W. and Herbert, and one daughter, Armenia, who has had almost the constant care of her mother. The oldest son, Merritt M., died about four years ago.
