Mrs. Carrie Rose, 85, a former well-known resident of Nunda, died Sept. 21, 1935, at the home of her daughter, Mrs. John D. Nelson, in Willoughby, Ohio, where she had made her home for the past several years. The remains were brought to Nunda Sunday and funeral services were held Monday afternoon at Duryea's Funeral Home, Rev. L.R. Lowrey, pastor of the Perry Universalist church, officiating. Burial was made in Oakwood Cemetery. The remains were accompanied to Nunda by Dr. and Mrs. John D. Nelson, their daughter, Mrs. Robert Elson, and her husband.

Carrie Willard Rose, daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Wilson Willard, resided in Nunda the greater part of her life. She was a woman who always thought of others first. That perhaps best sums up her philosophy of life which she practiced to a marked degree thruout a long life. Besides her daughter, Mrs. Fanny Nelson, she leaves one brother, Oscar J. Willard of Nunda; two nephews, Leon O. and Kenneth R. Willard of Nunda, and three grandchildren in Willoughby, Ohio.
