Many hearts were saddened by the news of the death of Ida, wife of Lester L. Rose, on Thursday, December 12th, at her home in Endicott. We have not learned the cause of her death. The funeral was Sunday. Mrs. Rose was formerly Ida Roberts and was born here, and all her younger years were lived in this village, and her three sons were born here. When Mr. Rose was elected sheriff they moved to Cooperstown and went from there to Endicott, where they have since lived, sometimes spending several months in the West where she took the baths and also visited her son. The greater part of her life she has been crippled and in constant pain from rheumatism, but bore her affliction with wonderful cheerfulness and courage. She leaves her husband, to whom she was a loyal wife, and was a devoted mother to her three sons of whom she was justly proud. They are Clyde, who with his family lives at home; Robert of Buffalo, Wyoming, a successful attorney who has served in the legislature, and Lee, who is an Episcopal priest in the Philippines; also several grandchildren. While here they were prominent members of the Universalist Church.
