Warren Ross Dies of Heart Attack in Flatbush Home  
Bookstore Proprietor Operated Shop for 15 Years—Led Merchants

Warren R. Ross, 40, one of the founders of the Flatbush Dependable Merchants and secretary since its organization four years ago, died suddenly of a heart attack Saturday evening in his home, 1116 Flatbush Ave.

Mr. Ross operated a book store at the Flatbush Ave. address for 15 years. He was an active worker in all of the activities of the merchants association.

Born up-State, Mr. Ross had resided in Brooklyn about 17 years. He is survived by his wife, Sonya, and two children, Elaine and Earl Ross. Services will be held at the Moadinger Funeral Chapel, 1120 Flatbush Ave., at 2 p.m. tomorrow, with the Rev. Cornelius Greenway, pastor of All Souls Universalist Church, officiating. Interment will be private.
