Mrs. Nathan Rounds Dead

Auburn, Sept. 10.—Mrs. Nathan [Jennie] Rounds died at her home in this city Thursday evening, after a lingering illness, covering a period of many months. She was a member of the Universalists church and the Ladies' Aid Society. Besides her husband, Mrs. Rounds is survived by her mother, one sister and three brothers, William Crawford of Syracuse being among the latter. The funeral will be held to-morrow afternoon at 3:30 o'clock from the family home in Foote street. Burial will be in Fort Hill [Cemetery].
