MRS. LOUISE ROUSE

Mrs. Louise Rouse, aged eighty-nine, widow of Carlos Rouse, died Tuesday at 8:30 a.m. at her home, 49 Susquehanna Avenue, after a three weeks' illness, due to the infirmities of her years. She had, however, been active until she suffered a fall, which hastened her decline.

A native of Cooperstown, she was born July 27, 1850, the daughter of Moses and Susan (Spencer) Misson. All of her years had been lived in this vicinity, the last forty years having been in this village, and prior to that on a farm at the top of Mt. Vision.

She married Carlos Rouse of Cooperstown, whose death occurred October 12, 1897. She was a very fine seamstress in her earlier days.

Her only immediate survivor is a son, Arthur Rouse, with whom she lived. There are also several cousins. The late Mrs. Emmett Chase of Pierstown was a sister.

The funeral will be held from the Funeral Home of Brown & Tillapaugh, Pioneer Street, Thursday afternoon at 2 p.m. The Rev. Charles Kramer, pastor of the Universalist church which she attended in her active years will officiate. Interment will be in Lakewood cemetery.
