## OBITUARY.

Elias W. Rudgers died at his home on the corner of Cherry and Center streets, Sunday June 4th at 8 o'clock after about a week's illness of asthama [sic] and uremic poisoning. Mr. Rudgers was born in the northern part of the town on the Rudgers homestead, in the year 1838. He was the eldest of 13 children born of Phoebe and Isaac Rudgers, his parents. He was married to Miss Louise Rudgers of Perry [on] February 8th, 1863. Mr. Rudgers lived on the farm upon which he was born until 32 years ago when he removed to Perry. He had charge of the farm until three years ago when he rented it to his son Lew Rudgers. Mr. Rudgers is survived by his wife Louise, one daughter Lena L. of Perry and two sons of Beach Park, Ohio and Lew W. of this place, also two brothers James H. Rudgers of Perry and I. C. Rudgers of Mr. Clair, N.Y., and one sister, Mrs. Hattie Davis of this place.

Funeral services were held from the late residence, Tuesday afternoon at 3 o'clock, Rev. John Evans officiating. Interment in Hope Cemetery.

Mr. Rudgers was a member of the Universalist Church of this place and he was highly respected by all who knew him.
