HENRY A. RUSCH RITES TOMORROW

Senior Partner of Factoring Firm Dies at 68 in Home at Center Island

Oyster Bay, May 30—Funeral services for Henry A. Rusch, who died Saturday night in his home on Center Island, will be held at 11 a.m. tomorrow in the Church of the Divine Paternity [Fourth Universalist], Central Park West and 76th St., Manhattan.

Mr. Rusch, who was 68, was senior partner in the firm of Rusch & Co., factors, of 1441 Broadway, Manhattan. Surviving are his widow, the former Florence Dolliver; two sons, Dr. Henry A. Rusch Jr. and Robert Rusch, and a daughter, Mrs. Elizabeth R. Chesley.
