Death at the Home of Mr. Crofoot's Mother

LE ROY, Dec. 5—Miss Felicia Russell died at midnight at the home of Mrs. Gideon R. Crofoot on East Main street after an illness of two weeks of Bright's disease, aged 62 years.

Miss Russell was the daughter of the late Stephen Russell and was born at Pavilion in 1836. She came to this village when about 20 years of age and made it her home with Mr. and Mrs. Crofoot on their farm south of this village. When Mrs. Crofoot removed into the village after her husband's death, Miss Russell came to the village to live with Mrs. Crofoot. One sister, Mrs. Mason Hoyt of Bailey's Mills, survives her.

The funeral will be held at the Universalist church tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock, the Rev. E.L. Conklin officiating. The burial will be at Machpelah cemetery.
