## FRANK EUGENE RUSSELL

The death of Frank Eugene Russell, a highly respected and life-long resident of this locality, occurred at his home on Chestnut street, at 1 o'clock Friday morning of last week. Although he had been in failing health for the past three months, his illness was of but ten days' duration. It is a remarkable fact that during a life of seventy-nine years his only sickness was his last one.
