## MRS. A. RYNKOWSKI

Death of Mrs. Antoinette Rynkowski, 79, occurred on Monday, Nov. 26, at the Warsaw hospital, where she had been ill since Saturday, Nov. 17. She had been in poor health for several months.

Born in Poland on June 4, 1876, she came to this country with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. John Mackowski, when she was four years old.
