MRS. SACKETT, 68, OF POTSDAM, DIES

Potsdam, May 2.—Mrs. Sarah¹ Sackett, widow of the late George Herbert Sackett, died at her home on the South Canton road near Crary Mills Thursday night. Funeral services will be held on Sunday at 2, Rev. H. [Herbert] P. Morrell [Universalist] of Canton officiating and interment will be in Bayside cemetery here.

Mrs. Sackett was a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Jonathan A. Hale and was born in the town of Pierrepont March 30, 1857. She was married to Mr. Sackett here 49 years ago and had been a resident of the farm where her death occurred [for] 47 years. Mr. Sackett died nine years ago.

Mrs. Sackett is survived by two sons, George E., who resides on the farm, and Harley A. Sackett, Potsdam shoe merchant. Two brothers, James and Harvey Hale of Pierrepont, and a sister, Mrs. E. E. [Abigail, wife of Elmer E.] Kimball of Potsdam, also survive.
