Miss Cora Sanders

A long illness which has confined her to her room for several years, last Wednesday evening at 8 o'clock claimed the life of Miss Cora Sanders, 71. She made her home with her sister, Mrs. Adella Bellinger, West Main street.

Miss Sanders was born in Danube on February 14, 1868, daughter [of] Alonzo and Mary Wagner Sanders. She did some practical nursing early in life, but was invalided by rheumatism for a large part of her life. She had resided at the Bellinger home for the past 20 years. She formerly attended the Universalist church in Fords Bush.

Although Miss Sanders' circle of acquaintances was necessarily limited, because of her long illness, those who knew her admired her fortitude. She leaves the sister mentioned, Mrs. Bellinger, and one brother, Howard Sanders, this village.

The funeral was held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Bellinger home, Rev. A. B. Hotchkiss, pastor of the Grace church, officiating. Burial was made in the Mount Hope cemetery at Fords Bush.
