SUSIE SANDERS DIES AT NATURAL BRIDGE

NATURAL BRIDGE, March 3.—Mrs. Susie Sanders, aged 76, widow of Frank Sanders, died from a shock [a stroke] Saturday morning at 8 o'clock at the home of Mrs. Louis Smith of Wilna. The shock was sustained while Mrs. Sanders was eating breakfast. Mrs. Sanders had been ill for the past three weeks with neuritis, but seemed to have fully recovered from her illness last Friday. She was up and about as usual Friday and feeling a great deal better.

Mrs. Sanders is the daughter of John and Mary Smith. She was born February 23, 1847, on the Hawkins farm. Upon her marriage to Frank Sanders, they took up their residence on the Redmond farm in Wilna. They retired from farming about 22 years ago. When her husband died 10 years ago, Mrs. Sanders made her home with her cousin, Mrs. Seymour. Upon the death of her cousin she made her home with Mrs. Smith, another cousin.

Mrs. Sanders was a member of the Universalist Church and of the Women's Relief Corps of which she was a former president. She was also a member of the grange.

Surviving her are a stepson, Ward Sanders of Oregon, and two cousins, Eliza Christian of Evans Mills and Mrs. Louis Smith of Wilna. Funeral arrangements are incomplete.
