Cornelia Bingham, widow of the late Dr. Willis Sawens, died in Detroit Sunday, aged 70 years. Mrs. Sawens will be kindly remembered by many people in this city, her former home. With her husband, Dr. Sawens, she came to Utica from Watertown in 1864. Their home was in Steuben Park, and the doctor conducted the drug business now carried on by Howarth & Ballard. Mrs. Sawens was an estimable lady, and attended the Church of the Reconciliation [Universalist]. She removed to Detroit five years ago. About a year ago [16 Aug 1894] Dr. Sawens died.
