SAWYER

Mrs. Ella P. Sawyer of Victor, widow of Henry H. Sawyer, died on Thursday, December 18, 1941 in the Canadaigua Health Home, where she had been for a few weeks. She had been in failing health for some time and for that reason had gone to the Health Home for the winter.

Ella P. Rushmore was born in Farmington on Christmas Day 1858, the only child of Lewis and Deborah Dennis Rushmore. She was married January 15, 1880 and they lived on the Sawyer or Rushmore farms in Farmington until 1903, when they moved into Victor village. They celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary at a reception in their home on Maple Avenue in 1930. Mr. Sawyer died about nine years ago [in 1932].

The surviving relatives are four cousins, John F. Rushmore and Mrs. George Henion of Palmyra, Mrs. Angie Treat and John W. Rushmore Jr. of Canandaigua.

Services were conducted from the home of John Rushmore in Canandaigua Sunday afternoon, the Rev. Nelson L. Lobdell [Universalist] of Victor officiating. Interment was made in the South Farmingon Cemetery.
