MRS. WILLARD SAXE, ILL TWO WEEKS, DIES  
Native of Ellisburg Expires From Heart Trouble

Mrs. H. Jennie Saxe, 76, 429 Holcomb street, widow of Willard E. Saxe, former sheriff of Jefferson county and for many years court clerk, died at her home early this afternoon following an illness of about two weeks. Death was due to heart trouble.

Mrs. Saxe had been in fair health until a short time ago. Her condition became acute two weeks ago and her condition grew rapidly worse until her death today.

She was born in the town of Ellisburg, March 28, 1850, a daughter of Luke and Lydia Terry Fulton. She passed her youth in the town of Ellisburg where she attended district schools. She married Willard E. Saxe at Ellisburg in 1869.

Mr. Saxe, who died in January, 1923 [1922], was one of the best known public officials in this vicinity, having served the county for more than 40 years. Mr. Saxe was elected sheriff of the county in the fall of 1887. Following a term as undersheriff at the conclusion of his term as sheriff, he was appointed court crier and special deputy county clerk, positions which he held for 20 years.

Mrs. Saxe is survived by two sisters, Miss Ella Fulton, 628 Boyd street, city, and Mrs. W. H. Fox, Mannsville.

The funeral arrangements have not yet been completed.
