## Died Full of Years

Yesterday morning at an early hour after protracted illness, passed away Keziah Warrick, wife of John R. Schenck, in the ninetieth year of her age. Had she lived until the 23rd day of August next, the day on which she was born at Trenton, N. J. in 1817, she would have been ninety years old.

Mrs. Schenck came to this section with her father's family when quite young and was married to John R. Schenck the 26th day of December, 1844.
