Karl A. Schick Dies

A funeral service will be held Wednesday for Karl A. Schick, 78, of 59 Walden Rd., who died yesterday (Oct. 9, 1955) after a long illness.

Mr. Schick was a sales agent for Prudential Life Insurance Co. here for many years before his retirement in 1934. From 1902 to 1918, he had been general superintendent of electrical installation and appliance sales for Rochester Gas & Electric Corp. He was a native of Philadelphia.

He is survived by his wife, Elva Seel Schick; two sons, Christian S. and Albert H., both of Rochester; a sister, Mrs. W. A. Rumpp, Philadelphia; three grandchildren, a niece and a nephew.
