Mrs. Mary Schultze

Mrs. Mary Green Schultze, 92, 4 Burwell street, Little Falls, died Sunday morning at Little Falls Hospital, where she had been a patient for two days. Mrs. Schultze had resided with her daughter, Mrs. Fred Irving, 4 Burwell street, for a number of years and had lived in Canajoharie for 40 years before residing in Little Falls.

Born May 29, 1867, in Sprakers, she was the daughter of Andrew and Eliza M. Smith Russ. Her marriage to William Green took place in Fort Plain in 1881.

Mr. Green died in 1895 and in 1909, she was married to Charles Schultze, the ceremony taking place in Fort Plain. Mr. Schultze died in 1913.

The deceased was a member of St. Paul's Universalist Church, Little Falls, and a charter member of the Class of the Friendly Heart of the church.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Fred Irving, Little Falls; a stepdaughter, Mrs. Walter Shubert, Canajoharie; five grandchildren, Dr. Mary Irving, Little Falls, Richard Irving, East Herkimer, Mrs. Allen Blackford, Harry Bills and Judson Bills, all of California; four great-grandchildren and seven great-great-grandchildren.

The funeral was held Wednesday afternoon at 2 from the Chapman Funeral Home, Little Falls, with Rev. Robert W. Sterling, pastor of St. Paul's Universalist Church officiating. Burial was made in Fort Plain Cemetery.
