GEORGE SCHUYLER RITES SATURDAY

FORT PLAIN, Jan. 12—George B. Schuyler died at St. Mary's hospital, Amsterdam.

He was born in Schenectady February 17, 1875, son of Joseph and Martha Bonstead Schuyler, and has resided most of his life here, where he conducted a restaurant and grill on Main street. He is survived by his widow, the former Ethel Spraker of this village, and several cousins.

The body was brought here by Undertakers B. Gray and Sons and taken to his home on Main street, where a prayer service will be held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Funeral services will be conducted at 2:30 o'clock at the Catherine Nellis Memorial chapel by Rev. C. R. Hamilton, pastor of First Baptist Church, and Rev. William H. [A.] Haney, pastor of the Universalist church. Burial will be made in the Fort Plain cemetery.
