The funeral of Mrs. Alice Robbins Scott was held from her late home near this village on Saturday afternoon at 2 p.m. Rev. Dewitt Lamphear officiated. Mrs. Scott died suddenly of heart disease at her home on Wednesday, May 9. She was the daughter of Frederick and Harriet Robbins and was born on the farm where she died. She was in her 69th year. Alice Robbins was married to W. Irving Scott in 1887. He died in 1910. Mrs. Scott had resided at her home here during the summers, but for several years had spent the winters with her sister, Mrs. Crandall, in Ithaca. Mrs. Scott was a modest, unassuming woman, of kindly and agreeable disposition, who always sought to do her part to the best of her ability. Having always lived in this community, she had a large acquaintance, and there were many knowing her who held her in high esteem and respect. She attended the Universalist church and was a member of the Bridgewater Woman's Art Club and was active in civic affairs. She is survived by one sister, Mrs. Myra Crandall of Ithaca, and a nephew, Frederick Morgan, of West Winfield. Interment was made in Fairview Cemetery.
