The death of Fred G. Scott removed a citizen who was highly regarded by a large number of friends throughout this vicinity. Mr. Scott was born in Scriba, Oswego county, May 8, 1852, and was a son of William and Mary Avery Scott. In 1875 he was married to Miss Emma Frances Clark. The family came to this village seven years ago. The survivors are his daughter-in-law Mrs. Flora Snell Scott, and five grandchildren, Dorothea, Marion, Wallace, Kenneth and Alvin Scott, all of this village. Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton of the Universalist church conducted the services, which were held from the late home on Wednesday. Interment was made in the Inghams Mills Cemetery. The bearers were: R. B. Beekman, Frank Ottman, W. J. Crangle, Charles Heath, all of St. Johnsville; funeral director, Henry Van Antwerp.
