BRIDGEWATER

Harriet Palmer, wife of Giles Scott and daughter of the late Abigail Spicer and William Palmer, died at her home New Year's eve, of pneumonia, after an illness of ten days. Mrs. Scott was born in Bridgewater the 30th of March, 1880, her mother dying when she was three days old. She was kindly cared for by her Aunts, Salina and Maria Palmer. She was educated in our school and the Oneonta Normal, graduating from there in 1900. After her graduation, she taught for three years in Central Valley, coming home from there to care for her aunt, who was ill with consumption. She taught in our school here until her marriage to Giles F. Scott in 1905. She was a member of the Universalist church and a teacher for some time in the Sunday school. She is survived by her husband, three sons, and two daughters; also one brother, Henry A. Palmer, of this town, and two aunts and a number of cousins. The funeral was held Friday and was private. Rev. D.[DeWitt] C. Lamphere officiated and the remains were laid to rest in the village cemetery.
