EDWARD A. SEAMAN EXPIRES, AGED 67
Former Painting Contractor, Watertown Resident 30 Years, Dies

Edward A. Seaman, aged 67 years, of 317 Academy street, died at his home late Friday afternoon. Mr. Seaman had been ill for about two weeks.

Funeral services will be held from the residence Monday afternoon at 2. Rev. Delbert G. Walker, D.D., pastor of the First Universalist church of Carthage, will officiate. Burial will be made in North Watertown.

Mr. Seaman was born in Gouverneur, the son of William H. and Anne Smith Seaman. He had resided in this city for the last 30 years. He was for some time a painting contractor, but gave up that work to become the custodian of the Academy street school. More recently he had been the custodian of the Marble block.

Surviving Mr. Seaman are his widow, Maria Kane Seaman; two children, Mildred and Hayward of this city; a brother, Charles N. Seaman of Cape Vincent; and three sisters, Mary E. of this city, and Mrs. William McIntyre and Mrs. N. [Norris] E. Marsh of Gouverneur.
