MRS. MARIE KANE SEAMEN

SHOULD BE MRS. MARIA KANE SEAMAN

Born in Martinsburg, July 9, 1861; Died in Watertown, January 1, 1932

Mrs. Maria Kane Seaman, 70, widow of Edward A. Seaman, 317 Academy street, Watertown, died Friday afternoon at the House of the Good Samaritan, where she had been a patient since Wednesday. Death was attributed to heart trouble. She had been ill for the last three weeks, but her health had been poor for the past two months.

Mrs. Seaman was born in Martinsburg, Lewis county, July 9, 1861, a daughter of the late Timothy and Mary Harigan Kane, and had been a resident of Watertown about 40 years.

She was married to Edward A. Seaman in Hoboken, N.J., Oct. 8, 1898. Mr. Seaman, a native of Gouverneur, was the son of the late William H. and Anne Smith Seaman and was a former contractor. Mr. Seaman died Nov. 24, 1922.

Surviving her are a daughter, Miss Mildred Seaman, and a son, Hayward Seaman, both of Watertown, and a brother, Edward Kane of Los Angeles, Calif.

Funeral services were held Monday, Rev. Dr. Harry Westbrook Reed, pastor of All Souls Universalist church, officiating. Burial will be in North Watertown cemetery.
