MISS LETA SEEBER

Little Falls—Miss Leta E. Seeber, 50, died in the local hospital yesterday. She had been in ill health for some time and had been receiving treatment at the hospital for several weeks.

She was born in Jacksonburg, Oct. 3, 1893, the daughter of Ella Harter Seeber and the late Henry Seeber. She was a graduate of the local high school and the Utica School of Commerce. In December, 1920, Miss Seeber entered the employ of the Herkimer County Trust Company as a bookkeeper, which position she held until 1926, when she became interest teller in the same bank. Illness forced her retirement the latter part of January this year.

Miss Seeber was a member of the Universalist Church. She was affiliated with its Friendly Heart class, Mary Washington Club, the Maude Cary Mission Circle, [and] the local Association of Universalist Women, and was a member of the board of trustees of the church. She was also a member of the Mohawk Valley Country Club, and the Alpha Kappa Pi sorority of this city.

Besides her mother, with whom she resided, she is survived by an uncle, three aunts and several cousins.

The body will be taken to the home of one of the aunts, Mrs. James Van Allen, 102 West Gansevoort St., this afternoon, from where the funeral will be held at 3:30 Thursday afternoon. The Rev. Howard Gilman, pastor of the local Universalist Church, will officiate. Burial will be in the Church St. Cemetery.
