MRS. SELWOOD DIES FRIDAY

Mrs. Mary H. Selwood, 81, of Fort Plain, widow of Ward Selwood, died Friday at 10:30 p.m. in Little Falls Hospital following a brief illness.

She was born Aug. 21, 1888 in Fort Plain, the daughter of the late Frank E. and Viola Brookman Hufnail. She was a member of the Universalist Church and the Chapin Club of the church.
