WM. H. SELWOOD TAKEN BY DEATH

FORT PLAIN, April 24.—William H. Selwood, aged 71 years, a native of Fort Plain, died Thursday afternoon at his home in New York city. Mr. Selwood moved to the big city about 38 years ago from Fort Plain. He was born August 16, 1854. Mr. Selwood had been ill for the past two months. He was well known among the older residents of this place. The survivors are his wife [Ella]; one daughter, Mrs. Charles Tyler, of New York; two brothers, Frank J. Selwood of Fort Plain [and] Rozelle Selwood of Ilion; three sisters, Mrs. Emma Williams of Richmond Hill, L.I., Mrs. Annie Carver and Mrs. Charles Z. [Sarah] Brandow of Fort Plain. The remains will be brought to this village Saturday afternoon and the funeral, which will be in charge of the Fort Plain Masonic lodge, of which Mr. Selwood was a member, will be held at 2:15 at the Catherine Nellis Memorial chapel, the Rev. Herbert F. Moulton, pastor of the local Universalist church, officiating. The interment will be made in the Fort Plain cemetery.
