Mrs. C. D. Sewell

Mrs. Katherine Gilchrist Sewell, wife of C. D. Sewell, died at her home, 38 Groton-ave., Wednesday after an illness of several months. Mrs. Sewell was born in Gilbertsville, N.Y. on June 12, 1875, and was the adopted daughter of Peter and Clara Gilchrist. She has made her home in Cortland for about two years, coming here from Oneonta. She was a member of the Universalist church of Oneonta.

She is survived by her husband, C. D. Sewell of this city; one son, Robert Sewell of Cortland and one daughter, Miss Ruth Sewell of this city; her mother Mrs. T. C. Gilchrist of this city; and two brothers, Rev. H. E. Gilchrist of Westfield, Mass., formerly of the Universalist church in Cortland, and Charles Hopkins of Gilbertsville.

Funeral services were held at the home Wednesday evening in charge of Rev. George J. Potter [Porter] and the remains were taken to Oneonta Thursday morning for burial.
