MRS. GEORGETTE SHAVER

Fulton, Feb. 3.—Mrs. Georgette Foster Shaver, a native of this city, died at her home in Syracuse Wednesday evening, following a brief illness.

For many years Mrs. Shaver was a leading concert singer and musician, being a member of leading Syracuse church choirs. At one time she was contralto soloist in the Plymouth Presbyterian church of Syracuse and conducted musical studios in both Syracuse and Fulton. She first studied under Prof. Grove Marsh of Syracuse and [line obliterated] Prof. Frederick H. Haywood of New York city.

Mrs. Shaver was a member of the Universalist church and of the Assa Danforth chapter of the D.A.R. She is survived by her husband, John H. Shaver; her mother, Mrs. Elizabeth J. Foster; a sister, Mrs. Charlotte F. Lewis, and a brother, A. Judson Foster, all of Syracuse.

Funeral services will be conducted Saturday afternoon at 1:30 at the late home, 1217 Valley Drive, Syracuse, by the Rev. Frederick W. Betts [minister of the Universalist Church]. Burial will be in the family plot at Mt. Adnah cemetery, Fulton.
