Mrs. Sheldon of Middleport Succumbs At 85

MIDDLEPORT—Mrs. Cora (Lord) Sheldon, 85, widow of Frank H. Sheldon and a former Middleport resident, died Tuesday at the O'Stewart Nursing Home, Gasport, where she had been a patient for 3½ years.
