MRS. A. M. SHELHORN, AGED 53, DIES AFTER SHORT ILLNESS

Mrs. Alice Moyer Shelhorn, aged 53 years, died at her home at (1???) West street shortly before midnight yesterday after a short illness. Death was due to a complication of diseases. Mrs. Shelhorn had resided in Utica for about 11 years. She was the widow of Frank J. Shelhorn, who died in 19(04?).

Mrs. Shelhorn was born at Starkville on June 3, 1868, being the daughter of Anderson and Amelia Moyer. The mother survives. She was married at Fort Plain to Frank J. Shelhorn in 1893, coming to Utica 10 years later, where she spent the remainder of her life. She was an attendant at the [Universalist] Church of the Reconciliation and a member of Golden Star Rebekah Lodge No. 263.

She is survived by her mother, Mrs. Ameila Moyer of Starkville; a brother, Fred Moyer of St. Johnsville; two sisters, Mrs. Ernest R. Ward and Mrs. Lulu Copeman of Utica, and an aunt and uncle, Mr. and Mrs. Romaine Filkins, also of this city.
