SHERWIN

The citizens of this village were greatly shocked Monday afternoon to learn of the sudden death of Mrs. Eva S. Sherwin. While she had been ailing for several days and Sunday had a fainting spell, it was thought she was exhausted by the care given her aged father, Mr. Nelson Edgerly who is very feeble and Sunday morning she went to her room and her physician attended her, when about four o'clock in the afternoon her attendant who had been absent from the room only a few minutes, found that death had claimed her. Eva S. Edgerly was born on Feb. 11, 1848, in this village where she was reared and grew to womanhood, and where in July 1885, she was united in marriage to Mr. John C. Peatie who died the same year, and on March 1897 she was married to James D. Sherwin and resided in Chicago several years. For several years she has been caring for her father, Mr. Nelson Edgerly who is 92 years of age and who survives her. The funeral was held from the home on Short street Wednesday afternoon, Rev. Clara Morgan [Universalist] officiating. Interment was in the family plot in Hope Cemetery.
