—On Monday, May 18th, Mr. Hiram Sherman died at his residence at West Henrietta, aged 74 years. He was born in Middletown, Rutland county, Vt., and when (?) years old came to Henrietta. He lived on the farm now occupied by his son-in-law Mr. [Benjamin] Ketchum, for fifty years. His health failing, he moved to West Henrietta, where he has lived for fourteen years and where he died. He leaves a wife [Laura], four daughters [Emeline, Nancy J., (wife of Benjamin Ketchum), Mary E., and Annie A.] and one son [Elijah] to mourn his loss. He was a very staunch Republican in politics and in religion a Universalist. He was universally respected and was held by all who knew him to be a good and faithful man.
