DR. L. V. SHERMAN BURIED IN CANTON

Funeral services for Dr. Lucius V. Sherman, Jr., 64, were held Friday afternoon, September 18 at 1:30 p.m. at the Lawrence funeral home. Burial took place in Fairview cemetery with the Rev. Theodore DeVries, pastor of the First Presbyterian church, officiating.

Dr. Sherman was born in Georgetown, Colorado on October 1, 1877, the son of Sophia McIntosh Sherman Hosley, now of Massena, and the late Lucius V. Sherman. He came to Canton as a boy and attended the Canton schools and St. Lawrence University in the class of 1900. After his graduation he took his dental training at Ohio State University.

He practiced dentistry with the late Dr. Fred Hosley in Canton until 1914. Since that time he had been located in Albany. On June 20, 1906, he married Flora Hitchcock of St. Regis Falls.

Many here well remember Lute Sherman when he was in college her as well as while he practiced dentistry. He was a handsome man, unusually likeable. He and Dr. Hosely maintained their dental offices over what is now the Merrill Brothers' store.

While in Canton Dr. Sherman was a member of the Universalist church, the Masons and the Maccabees and Foresters, as well as of the college fraternity of Beta Theta Pi.

He is survived by his wife; his mother, who celebrated her 90th birthday on Saturday at her home in Massena; a son, Harriman Sherman, who flew from Los Angeles, California to attend the funeral; a daughter, Mrs. Frederick W. Clements, of Troy; two sisters, Mrs. Nelson Gibson, of Massena, and Mrs. Fred Heaton of Atlanta, Georgia, and a grand-daughter of Troy.
