Mrs. Electa Shoemaker

Mrs. Electa Shoemaker died Sunday evening at the home of her son, Willard Shoemaker, 244 Mohawk street, after a long illness. She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Packard of Jacksonburg and was born April 10, 1829. Sixty years ago she was married to James Shoemaker, who died twenty years ago. Mrs. Shoemaker was a member of the Universalist Church. There are surviving two sons, Willard Shoemaker of this village and Marion Shoemaker of Buffalo and one brother, William Packard of Jacksonburg. The funeral will be held from the home of her son, Willard Shoemaker, at 2 o'clock Thursday afternoon, Rev. L. [Lewis] H. Robinson, pastor of the Universalist church, officiating. Burial will be in Oak Hill Cemetery.
