Death of George Nelson Short

The death of George Nelson Short occurred at his home on Hibbard avenue on Sunday evening, about 9:30 o'clock. He was born on what is known as the Short homestead, about three miles west of this village, on January 12, 1839, and lived there until 1894, when he went to reside with his son, Judson E. Short, on another farm nearby; about ten years ago they came to this village, and have since resided at the home where his death occurred. He was one of the most progressive and prosperous farmers of this vicinity. On March 13, 1867, Mr. Short was united in marriage to Miss Mary A. King, her death occurring on November 22, 1887. He is survived by his son, Judson E. Short, and one grandson, George N. Short, both of this village; a niece, Mrs. H. P. Reed of Livonia; and two nephews, H. N. King and H. Coates of Clifton Springs.

The funeral services were held at the home on Wednesday afternoon at two o'clock, and were conducted by Rev. E. [Edwin] P. Wood, pastor of the Universalist church at Victor. Burial was made in the family lot in Sunnyside cemetery, near Manchester Center.
