SOLOMON SHUMWAY

Le Roy, Jan. 4—Solomon Shumway died suddenly yesterday afternoon about 1 o'clock at his home in the Pavilion road, just south of this village. Although he had had some heart trouble for the past two years, he was in his usual health until about 7 o'clock yesterday morning, when pneumonia developed.

Mr. Shumway was born in the town of Sweden on July 30, 1834, being in his 88th year. About forty years ago he purchased a farm south of Le Roy on which he lived for 12 years and then removed to the place where his death occurred. In his earlier years he was fond of music and was an expert flute player. He was a member of the Le Roy Universalist Church so long as the society existed. In politics he was a Republican. His nearest relatives are two nephews, Wellington Nix and Frank Chadsey, of Brockport, and a niece, Miss Martha Raison, of Pittsford.

The funeral will be held on Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock from Mr. Shumway's late home, Rev. Clara Morgan of the Perry Universalist Church, officiating. Interment will be in Machpelah Cemetery.
