MRS. ALICE M. SIGLAR

Geneva, July 28.—The death of Mrs. Alice M. Siglar, aged 67 years, wife of Loomis F. Siglar, of No. 161 William street, occurred suddenly Friday night at the family home. The cause of death was heart disease with which Mrs. Siglar had been a sufferer for some time past. She is survived by her husband, two sons, Harry F. Siglar and George C. Siglar, of this city; three daughters, Mrs. A. S. Coolbaugh, of Towanda, Pa.; Mrs. W. A. Kenyon, of Washington, D. C. and Mrs. H. Effie Miles, of Geneva; four grandchildren, Harold Siglar, who is at Camp Raritan, N.J.; Robert Coolbaugh, who is at the army training camp at Pittsburgh University; Ethel Siglar and Albert Leonard, of this city. Mrs. Siglar was a member of the Woman's Relief Corps, having been at one time the Junior vice-president. She was a member of the Universalist Church.

The funeral will be held to-morrow afternoon at 2 o'clock from the residence. Rev. H. H. Kellogg, of this city, will officiate, and burial will be in Glenwood cemetery.
