GLOVERSVILLE, Nov. 4.—Albert N. Simmons, aged 70 years, died here early Sunday morning. He was born in this city and has made his home here ever since. He was among the city's best known business men and was descended from a pioneer family of this section, his mother being Julia A. Fox, a woman prominent here during her lifetime. He was a member of the Holy Cross Commandery, Knights Templar; Cyprus Temple of the Mystic Shrine, Johnstown Lodge Royal Arch Masons. He was a charter member of the Eccentric Club, the elite club of the city, and was also a charter member of All Soul's Universalist Church of this city. At his funeral Wednesday afternoon, the local pastor of the Universalist Church, Rev. Frank O. Hokerk will be assisted by Rev. Frederick W. Betts of Syracuse.
