The death of Mrs. John E. Simmons of Macedon occurred in the Newark Hospital on August 31, following an illness of five weeks. She was born in Walworth on October 24, 1862. Her husband conducted a barber-shop in Macedon for fifty years. Following the death of her husband [in 1940], she made her home with her niece, Mrs. Thomas Eaton of Ozone Park, Long Island and in recent years with Mrs. Sherman J. Baker of Macedon.

Mrs. Simmons was the oldest member of the Universalist Church in Macedon. She is survived by her brother, Edward Hurley, of West Walworth and several nephews and nieces. The funeral services were conducted by the Rev. Harry M. Wright of Bristol and the Rev. Frieda M. Ehlich of the Baptist church. Mr. Wright is a former minister of the Universalist church in Macedon.
