Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. W. R. [Grace] Balding Sr., of Geneseo, [and] Mrs. O. B. [Edna] Deyo of Little Falls and Homestead, Florida. Four grandchldren and 5 great grandchildren.

Funeral service was held on Saturday, March 20, with Rev. Leland Stewart of the Universalist Church officiating, in the C. Newitt Funeral Home in Little Falls. Interment was in Newville.
